

Internet service regulations of Pinzolo's library

1. The aims of the service

- a) The Trentino Library System recognizes the electronic information useful to meet the community's educational requirements.
- b) The library of Pinzolo, in accordance with the provincial project "Internet in the library", offers public free Internet
- c) Internet must be used abiding by the library rules. It must be considered a source of information for research, study and documentation.

2. The quality of information

- a) The producer is responsible for the information he gives in internet, therefore the user should examine closely the quality of information he receives.
- b) The library is not responsible for the information offered in internet.

3. How to approach the service

- a) Only the persons who have filled in an application form are allowed to use the service.
- b) The rule states that not more than two persons may use the computer site at the same time.
- c) A reservation is necessary for using internet.
- d) Each user can utilize internet for not more than one hour per day, and not more than two hours per week. If the user isn't present within 15 minutes from the beginning of his reserved hour, the site is considered free. There isn't any possibility to do that hour later, if you are late or if there are technical problems.
- e) Each user must sign the library register which contains the date, the hour and the computer site used.
- f) The access to internet is free.
- g) You have only to pay:
 - the printed papers, shaped A4 in black and white £ 200 each
 - the magnetic supports for datas downloading £ 1500 each

4. Assistance

- a) The library personnel gives the users base assistance, in so far as duty allows.

5. Available services for the audience

- a) The following services are available:
 - consultation web pages, Telnet
 - downloading data only into new disks provided by the library
 - printing
 - electronic mail at free e-mail sites
 - joining at mailing list and at on line conferences (newsgroup)
- b) If the disks go out from the library, they can not be reused at the library computer
- c) The librarian can not permit downloading and printing operations of the data for a supplementary time
- d) The use of e-mail must abide by the aims of internet in the library (article 1 of these regulations)

6. These services are not available

- Account of e-mail
- Files uploading in the net
- Instant messaging and chat (IRC)
- Virtual phoning

7. Responsibilities and obligations for the user

- a) Internet can't be used for aims forbidden by the present rules
- b) The user is civilly and penally responsible for the use of internet service. The library has the authority to report the user to the authorities for illegal activities. The user must pay for the damages of the computers.
- c) The user is responsible for violations to the protected accesses, the copyrights and the using permissions
- d) It is forbidden to change the data put inside by other users and to do operations that could influence negatively the regular work in the net
- e) It is forbidden to alter the software and hardware of the library computers. The installation of software in the library computers is permitted only if it helps to extend the original functions of the browser (plug-in etc.) and it must be authorised by the library.

8. Sanctions

- a) Violation of the rules can imply:
- Stopping the session
 - Stopping access to the service
 - Reporting to appropriate authorities

9. Minors

- a) The permission slip for the minors must be signed by one parent (or someone else in the place of him) who has to examine the rules.
- b) Library personnel are not responsible for assisting minors in using internet
